The AGA Rates Course “offers intensive study of the natural gas industry and its regulation. Taught by recognized experts in the field, this program focuses on the details of ratemaking through intensive classroom work, study groups and lectures.”

Mr. Yagelski is also speaking at the Wisconsin Public Utility Institute (“WPUI”) Energy Utility Basics Fundamental Course regarding “What Everyone Ought to Know About Gas”, “Providing Natural Gas Service – Wholesale” and “A Day in the Life of a Gas Company” on Thursday and Friday, October 28 and 29, 2010 at the University of Wisconsin, Madison, Wisconsin.

Energy Utility Basics is an annual course promoted by the National Association of Regulatory Commissioners (“NARUC”) that offers “an introduction to the electric and natural gas industries, insights into regulatory decision-making, and an analysis of the current issues facing both industries.”

Mr. Yagelski has most recently assisted his energy clients with natural gas market assessments, capacity resource portfolio development, demand forecasting analysis, peer benchmarking studies, and capacity optimization revenue evaluations. He has over twenty years of direct experience in natural gas and electric utility management in the areas of system and resource planning, contracting, sourcing, asset optimization, engineering, and local and federal regulatory matters. Mr. Yagelski received his Bachelor of Science degree from the College of Electrical Engineering at Purdue University and is a Registered Gas Distribution Professional. He has been an expert witness in several regulatory proceedings and government hearings, an instructor for courses conducted by industry associations, and a speaker at energy industry events. Prior to joining Concentric, Mr. Yagelski was Director of Energy Acquisition and Department Head of Regulatory Affairs for Washington Gas and Lead Planning Engineer and Project Manager for Illinois Power (now Ameren). Throughout his career, he has held leadership and committee positions within the American Gas Association (AGA), the North American Energy Standards Board (“NAESB”), and the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers (“IEEE”).
